Temporary Restrictions on Local Waterways

To protect sensitive riparian areas and the safety of festivalgoers, the Province has authorized local authorities to temporarily restrict access to the Lillooet River at the Highway 99 bridge, the Birkenhead River, and the Green River. Closures will be clearly marked and managed by the Squamish-Lillooet Regional District, Village of Pemberton, and Líl'wat Nation.

Temporary Two Hour Parking in Downtown Core

To ensure adequate street parking for residents, temporary two hour parking regulations will be in effect July 12th to July 17th. Downtown businesses can obtain permits for employee day parking at the Village Office.

Residential street parking will only be permitted if the vehicle displays a Village issued parking permit. Permits are available at the Village Office (7400 Prospect Street).

Locals Park'n' Ride & Carpool Parking

Residents who carpool or take transit to Whistler can park in the Local's Park'n'Ride & Carpool parking in the parking lot beside the Community Barn.

Please note, camping or overnight parking is not permitted in this parking lot. Those in violation will be towed at the owner's expense.

Traffic Pattern Change on Frontier Street North

Frontier Street North (adjacent to the Community Barn) will be temporarily one-way northbound. This temporary traffic pattern change will be in place July 12th to July 17th, to ensure pedestrian safety in the festival shuttle pick-up zone (located at the barn). Please note, Accessible Parking will be relocated from Frontier Street, to Birch Street and will be clearly marked.
