

VILLAGE OF PEMBERTON

BYLAW No. 740. 2013

---

Being a bylaw to amend the Village of Pemberton Official Community Plan  
Designation Bylaw No. 654, 2011

---

**WHEREAS** the Council may amend its Official Community Plan from time to time;

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of the Village of Pemberton deems it desirable to amend the Official Community Plan to designate certain lands in the Hillside Special Planning Area for community recreation uses;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Village of Pemberton in open meeting assembled **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. **CITATION**

This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Official Community Plan Amendment (Recreation Site) Bylaw No. 740, 2013."

2. **Village of Pemberton Official Community Plan Designation Bylaw No. 654, 2011 is amended by:**

- (a) Delete the "Land Use" definition of "Recreation" in Section 6.0 with the following:

*Recreation Designation means lands which accommodate public, private or not for profit organizations that operate recreation activities, including but not limited to playing fields, arena, fieldhouse, swimming pool, campgrounds, equestrian facilities, golf courses, shooting ranges; and other sporting/leisure activities.*

- (b) Amend Map B "Land Use" by adding and designating the lands outlined with the black dotted in Schedule 1 as "Recreation".

**READ A FIRST TIME** this 1<sup>st</sup> day of October, 2013.

**READ A SECOND TIME** this 1<sup>st</sup> day of October, 2013.

**RESOLUTION OF INTENT TO HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING TO AMEND** the Village of Pemberton Official Community Plan Bylaw No. 654, 2011 was **PUBLISHED IN THE Whistler Question** October 29<sup>th</sup>, 2013 and **Pique Newsmagazine** October 31, 2013.
