

Public Works Labourer – Term Position

Full-Time, 6-month Term Position, (40 hours/week)
Reports to Public Works Supervisor
Pay rate: \$25.02/hour

General Outline, Scope and Purpose:

Reporting to the Public Works Supervisor, the Public Works Labourer will perform a variety of duties related to the operation and maintenance of Village infrastructure. The Public Works Labourer will demonstrate good judgement and possess strong interpersonal and teamwork skills. Activities related to this position are often strenuous in nature and require an individual who is physically fit and safety conscious.

Responsibilities:

- Maintain cleanliness of Village facilities such as public washrooms, parking lots, Public Works Shop and Village Office including:
 - Cleaning washrooms
 - Litter pickup and garbage collection
 - Garbage and recycling disposal
- Operation of company vehicles
- Perform basic repairs and maintenance duties to roads, trails, signs and sidewalks
- Assist with basic renovation projects as required
- Conduct inspections and basic repairs of Village equipment and infrastructure
- Ordering and pick-up of parts and other items
- Support Parks maintenance team as needed
- Other duties as required.

Qualifications:

- Class 5 Driver's License and satisfactory Driver's Abstract required
- Minimum of 3 years' related experience in a similar role
- Ability to operate power tools and small equipment
- Must be physically fit, capable of lifting up to 50 lbs safely, and working for up to eight hours in inclement weather
- Strong verbal communications and customer service skills
- Ability to work both independently and as a member of team
- Grade 12 education required, post-secondary education an asset
- Local government experience an asset
- Air brakes endorsed license an asset
- First Aid and other workplace safety certifications an asset.

The position of Public Works Labourer is included in the Collective Agreement between the Village of Pemberton and Canadian Union of Public Employees, Local 2010.
