



Builders' Bulletin: Building a Deck

For a detached (single-family) dwelling


The drawings below indicate the requirements specified by the BC Building Code.






NOTE: Maximum cantilevers apply when joists carry uniform distributed roof loads. Other point loads to transfer directly to the foundation.

Guardrail Design



NOTE: 150mm (6") clearance required from bottom of untreated wood to grade.

Foundation Options



Permanent foundations

Required when decks are attached to the house and if a roof structure or other enclosure will be constructed. Permanent foundations such as 24" x 24" footings 2' below grade are required. **Additional detail drawings must be submitted** for review.



Checklist: Deck

For a detached (single-family) dwelling

Application Requirements

A standard building permit application can be located on the Village of Pemberton website and is required for a deck. The following items must be completed and submitted:

- Forms A/B/C (Item 1)
- Scope of work (Item 2)
- Current Certificate of Title (within last 30 days), and copies of registered documents (easements, covenants & right-of-ways) may be required (Item 6)
- Engineer's Design and Schedule B and proof of insurance, if applicable (Item 8)
- Strata Authorization is required if applicable (Item 11)
- Two paper sets and one PDF set of scaled plans which shall include:
 - All dimensions, lot size and accurate shape showing the size of the proposed deck.
 - The exact location of the proposed deck in reference to other structures, property lines, all registered easements, right-of-ways, existing retaining walls and proposed retaining walls.
 - Working drawings shall show all building elevations, foundation/footing plans, and a cross-section showing all construction assemblies.
 - The material and design of the deck and the location and specifications of guard railings.
 - Plans must be drawn to scale. Preferred scale Metric 1:50
 or Imperial ¼" = 1.0 ft.
 - All construction shall conform to the BC Building Code. Refer to drawings above for code standards for decks.
