- **Students will be met outside the front entrance** (north entrance, Cottonwood Street) by the instructor.
- There will be no parent access to the facility. Pemberton and District Community Centre will remain closed to the public and will be open for registered programs and fitness centre use only.
- **Students are required to bring** their own art journal, sketch pad or paper, eraser, sharpener and mark making tools such as pencils, pastel or charcoal.
- Additional supplies will be provided when necessary. Supplies will be disinfected before and after class and quarantined for 72 hours after use.
- Children will be sat at individual tables with the exception of children from the same household.
- Children are encouraged to use the washroom prior to arriving at the Pemberton and District Community Centre. Washroom use in the facility should be avoided unless absolutely necessary. When necessary, children will be sent one at a time as per the washroom occupancy limit.
- The instructor will wear a mask when assistance is required and physical distancing is not possible.
- Pick-up after class will be conducted outside the opposite side of the building (south entrance, Portage rd). A caregiver must be present during pick-up. **Children will not be permitted to sign themselves out.**
