Duties:

 - o Litter pickup and garbage collection
 - o Garbage and recycling disposal
- Carry out works related to municipal parks maintenance and landscaping development, maintaining flower beds, trees, shrubs, trails, turf areas, parks including, but not limited to, weeding, mowing grass, litter pickup, pruning and fertilizing.
- Support parks and trail maintenance to provide a safe place for the public to recreate while practicing physical distancing.
- Operate and maintain tools and equipment related to the work, including, but not limited to, lawnmowers, weed eaters, edger, and janitorial equipment.
- Perform cleaning, painting and minor repairs to municipal facilities and equipment.
- Perform other duties as assigned.
