Program Leader – Drop-In Sports

Location: Pemberton & District Community Centre, Pemberton Casual position; hours include afternoons and/or evenings

Summary:

The Recreation team offers drop-in sports like pickleball, soccer and basketball for adults throughout the week. The Program Leader will be responsible for the facilitation and implementation of these sessions.

Responsibilities:

- Lead, supervise, and engage with participants in program activities
- Follow policies and procedures relating to organized sports
- Maintain a controlled environment and encourage co-operation, problem solving and conflict resolution
- Assist with some program planning, and ensure the development of safe, fun, and ageappropriate activities
- Take part in the activity alongside participants when capacity and resources allow
- Perform other related duties as required

Skills and Experience:

- Ability to build rapport with participants and co-workers
- Some knowledge of program leadership
- Experience with the above sports or similar activities desirable
- Able to work independently, use sound judgement, and make confident decisions relating to program safety, policies, and procedures
