BYLAW NO. 603, 2007

New Well Loan Authorization Bylaw

Being a By-law to authorize the borrowing of the cost to secure a new well

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary to provide a secondary source of water for the Village of Pemberton;

AND WHEREAS the estimated cost of the work is the sum of \$924,740 of which \$924,740 is the amount of debt created by this bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Village of Pemberton in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

- The Council is hereby empowered and authorized to provide, operate and maintain, and to undertake and carry out, or cause to be carried out the Water Improvement Services and to do all things necessary in connection therewith for the benefit of the properties with the Village of Pemberton and without limiting the generality of the foregoing:
 - a) To borrow upon the credit of the Municipality a sum not exceeding \$924,740.
- 2. The maximum term for which debentures may be issued to secure the debt created by this bylaw is thirty (30) years.
- 3. This bylaw may be cited as "New Well Loan Authorization Bylaw No. 603, 2007".
