Council Procedure Amendment Bylaw

Village of Pemberton

Bylaw 557, 2005

A bylaw to amend the Council Procedure Bylaw No. 530, 2004.

WHEREAS Council did, on the 29th day of April, 2004, adopt Bylaw number 530 of the Village cited as the "Council Procedure Bylaw No. 530, 2004";

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to amend the Bylaw to adjust the start time of some of the Council meetings, amongst other things;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of the Village of Pemberton, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1. Section 2 Definitions of the said Bylaw No. 530 is hereby amended by adding the following definition:
 - "Delegation" means a person or persons chosen to represent others and/or an individual.
- 2. Subsection (2) of Section 5. of the said Bylaw No. 530 is hereby amended by:
 - a) Deleting the words and figures "and 1:30 p.m. respectively" from the end of clause (b); and
 - b) Deleting the words and figures "and 4:30 p.m. respectively" as they appear in the first line of clause (c); and
 - c) Adding a new clause (e) as follows:
 - "(e) notwithstanding clause (a) above, there shall only be one Council Meeting during the month of July and it shall be held on the first Tuesday after July 1st and one Council meeting during the month of August and it shall be held on the second Tuesday."
- 3. Section 18 of the said bylaw No. 530 is hereby amended by inserting the following as a new subsection (4) and the existing subsections (4) and (5) are renumbered as subsections (5) and (6) of section 18:
- "(4) The Corporate Officer may schedule a maximum of two delegations to any Council meeting provided the Corporate Officer shall have received a written request explaining the subject matter to be discussed with Council no later than fourteen days prior to the scheduled Council Meeting."
